Following successful completion of the University of Hertfordshire's Bachelor's degree you will be able to apply to continue your studies to Master's level with the University, benefitting from a 20% Graduate scholarship. Please be aware that minimum Bachelor's grades will be required.

Please note, if your offer has an English language condition included, this is expressed as an IELTS requirement. However we do accept other English language test providers, for full details please see the University's website. The Home Office is currently investigating English language tests administered by Educational Testing Service (ETS) which includes the TOEFL test. Currently UK Visas & Immigration has suspended the consideration of all applications made in the UK for further leave to remain where a TOEFL test to prove English language ability is used. TOEFL tests are still being considered for visa applications made outside of the UK but you could experience considerable delays with your visa if you are relying on this test. Financial Conditions

In order to confirm your place you must pay a deposit of £5000 (unless your fees are being paid by an approved sponsor): details on how you may make your payment may be found here. If you are beingsponsored, then instead of paying a deposit you must provide us with satisfactory proof of sponsorship to cover the entire cost of your course. The final deadline for the payment of deposits or receipt of evidence of sponsorship is 22/08/14 (TBC). If we have not received either by this date, this offer will be deemed to have been withdrawn.
