Our fees are reviewed annually and as an international student your tuition fees are subject to a maximum annual increase of the higher of 5% or the UK RPI measure of inflation. International students are required to pay a deposit of £3,000 before enrolment instructions can be sent and a Confirmation of Acceptance for Studies (CAS) number can be issued, if required. The final deadline to pay the deposit for applicants starting in September is the 31 August 2020; applicants with a later start date must pay their deposit one month prior to their start date.
